

Should my child come to school?

A guide for parents who are concerned their child *may* have symptoms of coronavirus

Does my child have (or recently had):

- A high temperature?
- new continuous cough (this means coughing a lot for more than an hour or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours)?
- Loss or change of taste or sense of smell?

Yes

CHILD GETS COVID TEST
– CALL NHS Number 119
Inform school of result

Whilst awaiting result, even if symptoms desist, we advise:

- Child stays at home
- Do not have visitors
- Only leave your home to have a test

Positive

Child Stay at home for at least 10 days and temperature has gone

Not sure

NHS 111 advise to take a test

CALL NHS Number 111 AND SEEK ADVICE.
Inform school of result

Negative

Child feels well enough to attend school

Child can go to school

Child does not feel well in themselves

Stay at home until ...

NHS 111 symptoms are not conducive with COVID-19

NO

The school can take the decision to refuse a child's attendance at school if in our reasonable judgement it is necessary to protect our pupils and staff from possible infection from coronavirus.
